## Our programmes



#### **Helpline Response Team**

Our Domestic Abuse Helpline team provides support, advice, and information to anyone impacted by domestic abuse, including friends, family, and affected others. Where appropriate, they will carry out a risk assessment, complete safety planning, empower people to understand their options, and refer them to the best support to make decisions about their future.



## Independent Domestic Violence Advisors (IDVAs)

Our Independent Domestic Violence Advisors support hundreds of high-risk individuals and families. From the point of crisis, we'll work alongside them to understand their personal circumstances, create a personal safety plan, and help them implement it in the short and longer term.



# Domestic Abuse Support Advisors (DASAs)

Our Domestic Abuse Support Advisors are trained to help. They'll listen and advocate on people's behalf, acting as their voice when they don't feel able to, and making sure their views are heard.



#### **Recovery Pathway**

Our Recovery Pathways service triage individuals and families to work out the best support to meet their needs. It then provides suitable therapeutic support that takes into account each individual's trauma experience, focuses on solutions, and is delivered by accredited specialists



#### Recovery support programmes

The SUsie Programme (SUsie Project) provides group work support to people recovering from domestic abuse. This programme helps clients to recover from the impact of domestic abuse and to positively move forward with their lives. It focuses on long-term wellbeing and is designed to address the impact of abuse and enable people to develop future protective behaviours.

Reconnect is tailored towards children and young people aged 8-15 years of age who have been affected by domestic abuse. The programme aim is to help to improve their resilience and to make a long term recovery.



#### Behaviour change programme

Change 4 U is a domestic abuse programme which provides group support to people who display abusive behaviour within their relationships. It aims to re-educate clients about beliefs and behaviours so they can develop respectful, responsible attitudes towards others and themselves. The programme provides a wide range of support to partners and expartners to keep families safe.



#### Education

The Healthy Relationships Programme is a programme designed to enable and equip children and young people to have a clear understanding of what constitutes a healthy and respectful relationship, so they can make informed and safe decisions throughout their life.
